Fish availability is limited. Pre-orders must be picked up within 24 hours of delivery. Payment for fish due in full by 5/8/17. Liability for fish health passes to the buyer upon pickup. Boxing fee for pickup orders- \$5 per box.

Pond Site Stocking: \$300 minimum order for pond site deliveries. Delivery fee- \$2 per loaded mile

STOCKING TIPS:

When stocking your pond, balance IS important. Ponds should be stocked at a rate of 3 prey for every predator fish. Choosing to overstock with predator fish will affect growth and reproduction rates.

To promote growth rates, begin daily feedings after new fish stocking. New fish are better trained on feed than established fish in a pond. Using quality food is the key to yielding the best growth and limit the amount of fish waste.

New pond? Don't forget about habitat. For fish to survive and thrive they need habitat for protection and spawning. Artificial trees anchored to the bottom of the pond are a great habitat option for small fish. Adding non-invasive aquatic plants around the margins of the pond also create a great space for small fish and other aquatic life to thrive. Flat rocks or planks raised slightly off the pond bottom around the edges are perfect for fathead minnows to spawn.

When stocking your new fish, be sure to acclimate them to your pond water. Failure to acclimate the fish can shock fish and lead to death. Mix some pond water with the transportation water. Allow the water to sit for about 15 minutes.
